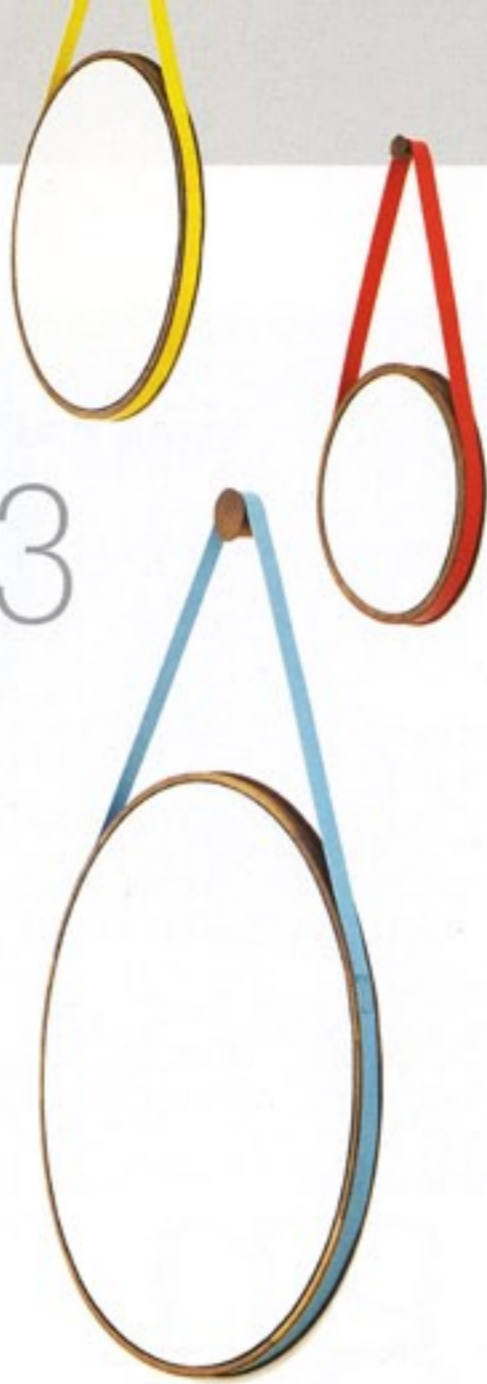


13 Being Blease

17 Baines & Fricker

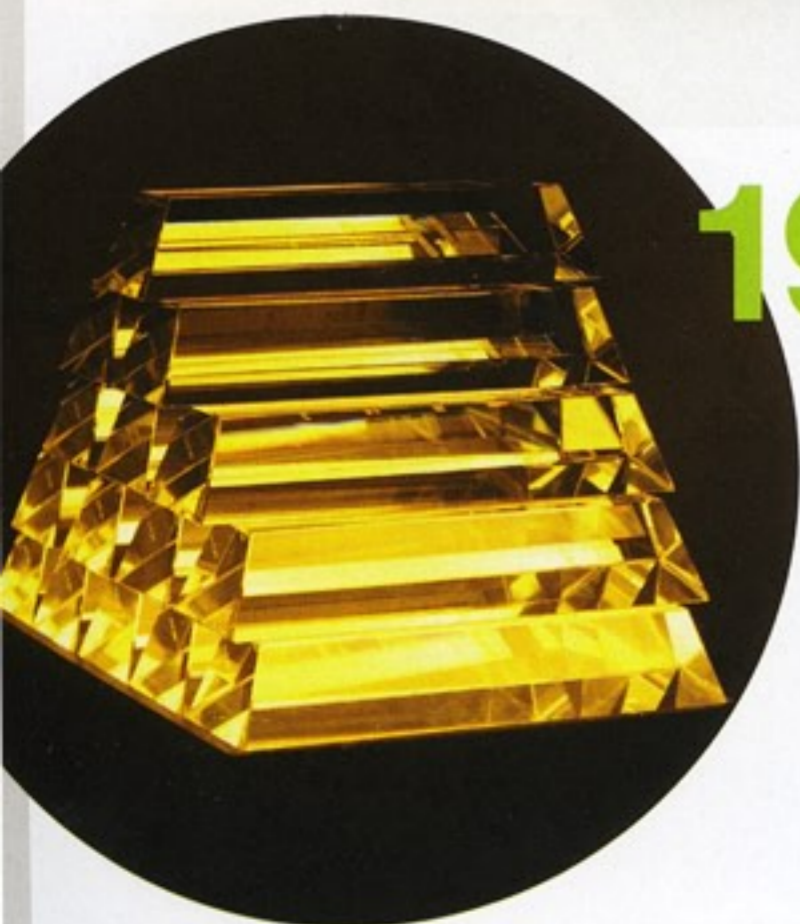

Made from hand-cut and polished K9 crystal on an American black walnut base, Aurum is a sculptural lighting system that glows and refracts light when illuminated. The Equilibrium coffee table is hand made in Scotland and features a cantilevered surface, which can be specified in walnut, ash or oak, combined with a powder-coated steel support available in various colours.
